The Township of Tay has initiated a Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) to investigate opportunities to improve the water and wastewater services to all properties in the Grandview Beach and Paradise Point community.

How Will This Affect Me?

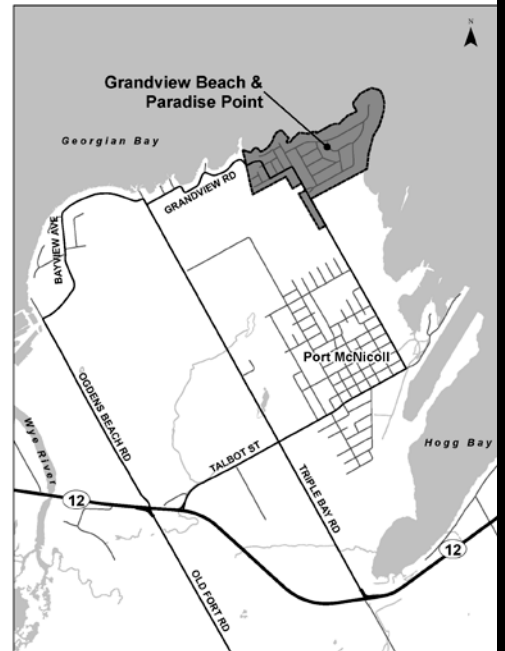
The study will assess the quality of drinking water and the effectiveness of wastewater treatment in the community, review the planning and development freeze in place since the 1970s, and consider funding models to support the study recommendations.

Public and agency consultation is a key element of the process, and input will be sought throughout the study to identify options to address the study findings. Based on this input, alternative strategies will be evaluated to identify optimal community, environmental and economic opportunities.
