

B. NUMBERING PROTOCOL FOR THE CONSOLIDATED BY-LAW

Consistent numbering has been established to make it easier to use and administer General Zoning By-law No. 2000-57. The numbering protocol will also assist in the preparation of amendments to the by-law.

The General Zoning By-law is divided into 32 Sections and a decimal numbering system has been used to identify particular requirements and provisions. The first number indicates the section of the By-law; the second, the sub-section; the third, the article. An article may be further broken down into clauses, sub-clauses, sentences, and sub-sentences (indicated by numbers in brackets).

The numbering protocol utilized in By-law No. 2000-57 is illustrated as follows:
