MUNICIPAL WATER RESTRICTIONS

Outside water use during the heat of the summer more than doubles the demand for Municipal water, and much like conserving energy to avoid blackouts, we must all do our part to conserve our water supply.

No one wants the inconvenience of running out of water for drinking, bathing and other sanitary uses.

Running out of water for fire protection is an even bigger concern. If our storage tanks cannot maintain adequate levels of water, we cannot fight fires.

Therefore, Township staff would like to remind all residents on the Municipal water system of the following restrictions on outside water use:

Outside use is RESTRICTED to the days of the month corresponding with your civic address, meaning:

**EVEN NUMBERED HOUSES ON EVEN CALENDER DAYS
ODD NUMBERED HOUSES ON ODD CALENDER DAYS**

Outside use is restricted to the hours of **7:00 am to 9:00 am and 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm.**

All residents using municipal water are restricted to one (1) outside faucet.

As per, Bylaw #96-25 (1) Using Township supplied water outside when prohibited would be subject to a \$130 fine.
