



MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS 2010 COMPLIANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE

The Towns of Midland and Penetanguishene and the Townships of Tay and Tiny, in accordance with the Municipal Act, 2001 as amended, will be receiving applications for appointments to a Compliance Audit Committee for the 2010 Municipal Election. The Compliance Audit Committee as outlined in the Act, has been delegated the duties of considering applications received for the review of municipal candidates' election campaign finances.

The Compliance Audit Committee will be composed of a total of five (5) eligible electors from the Towns of Midland and Penetanguishene, Townships of Tay and Tiny. The appointment is for a term of four (4) years commencing December 1, 2010.

The following are excluded from being members of the Committee:

- Candidates from the 2010 Municipal Election
- Council or Local Board Members
- Municipal Employees

Interested applicants must be eligible electors in their respective municipality. Experience in the financial or legal sector would be considered an asset.

Committee meetings will be held as required and members will receive remuneration of \$75 per meeting attended.

All interested parties who wish to be considered for appointment are encouraged to submit a letter of interest outlining your qualifications to the undersigned **prior to August 19, 2010.**
