




NOTICE of the Passing of a By-law to Dissolve Ward Boundaries

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Tay passed By-law 2021-35 on the 23rd day of June, 2021 pursuant to Section 222 of *the Municipal Act, 2001*.

AND TAKE NOTICE that By-law 2021-35 provides for dissolution of Wards and the implementation of an 'At-Large System of Electoral Representation'.



AND TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Subsection 222(4) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, any person or agency may appeal within 45 days of the passing of the by-law to the Ontario Land Tribunal in respect of the by-law by filing with the Clerk of The Corporation of the Township of Tay a notice of appeal setting out the objections to the by-law and the reasons in support of the objections. This notice of appeal must be accompanied by a certified cheque or money order in the amount of \$1,100.00 made payable to the Minister of Finance.

Any notice of appeal must be filed with the Clerk's Office of the Township of Tay, at the address below, **not later than 4:30 p.m. on the 9th day of August, 2021**.
